

# Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

Dear Parents,

KS2 had a very exciting surprise this afternoon when they were invited to see HRH The Princess Royal at Heckington Windmill. Princess Anne formally opened the Windmill Regeneration Project, so it was lovely for some of the children to take part in this very special occasion for the village, by seeing her briefly as she completed her visit.

Governors have recently reviewed the school Uniform Policy and you should receive a copy of this through ParentHub. It will also be updated on the school website. Having a consistent uniform helps our children to feel part of the school community, and helps our community to feel proud of their school. We appreciate parental support in maintaining the high standards we aspire to.

Staff will be adhering to the new policy from next week, especially with regard to jewellery, makeup and hair. We appreciate however, that some sections of the policy introduce more significant changes, for example house coloured T-shirts for PE, the removal of white polo shirts to be replaced with all green, and the removal of sweatshirts and cardigans without the school logo. We do not expect parents to buy replacement items immediately when many have only purchased items in September. The PTFA are currently investigating suppliers for the newer items and we will write to parents again to let you know when these will be available. Therefore these parts of the policy will be introduced gradually, with a view to parents replacing items as children grow out of them with the new policy. We expect all children to be fully complying with the new policy by September 2018 at the latest.
