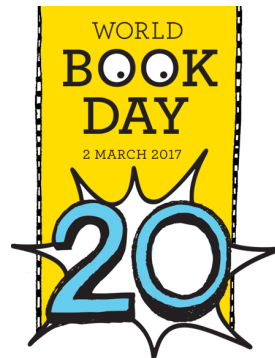

FARM KITCHEN DEADLINE CHANGE

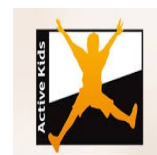
