Gates will be locked from 3.40pm for the duration of after school clubs. Your child will be released from the front side gate by club leaders at the end of the club.

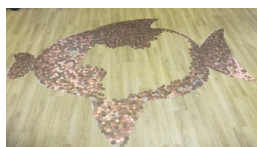
Friday Read—could all parents/carers attending Friday Read come through the Office and sign in. Please remember to sign out as well.
