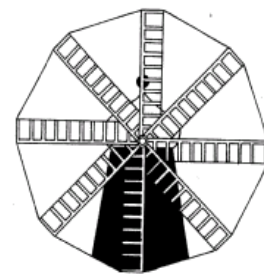

The Windmill Shop is having an open evening tonight—**Thursday 22nd 6pm-9pm**— Why not drop in and see what festive treats they have.

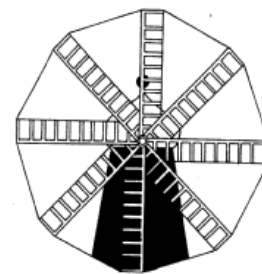

I bring a love of the children and a desire to see them progress in their development both academically as well as learning to discover and develop their unique 'God given' gifts and talents.

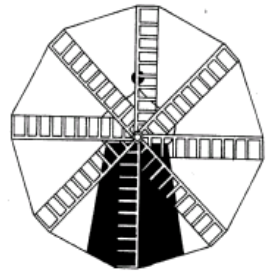
