



COVID 19 reopening protocols for using outdoor/outdoor learning

Outdoor areas available for use

- Each learning bubble has been allocated a space for use at break times, lunch times and for any outdoor learning. They must remain in this area at all times.
- The following areas will not be available for use by any bubble throughout their time in school:
 - Outdoor wooden play equipment – this will be taped off with barrier tape.
 - Stage area

Break times and Lunchtimes:

- Bubbles have been allocated specific times for their break time in order to minimise the number of children outside at any one time.
- Each bubble can choose an appropriate time for when to be outdoors. Outdoor learning is encouraged although weather conditions must be considered.
- Children will have had sun cream applied at home. If parents feel that further applications are required during the day, they should teach their child how to do this. A staff member can support from a distance. Children should bring sun hats.

Toys/outdoor play equipment:

- Children will be encouraged to play games that do not involve contact or sharing of equipment.

Toilets/handwashing:

- Children may only use their dedicated set of toilets during a break time, entering the building through a specific door to avoid corridors as much as possible. Toilets will be monitored by an adult at break times.
- Children and staff must wash their hands immediately when entering the building.
