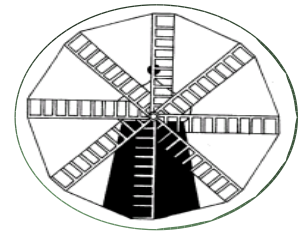


Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

if you can help your class to win!

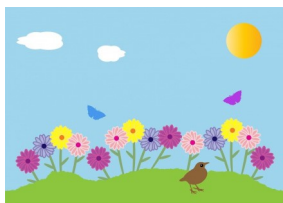
Let the battles commence!
