

From September 2023, parents of LAC and PLAC pupils will receive a 50% reduction in lesson fees up to a 20min lesson and free instrument hire. From September 2023, pupils entitled to Free School Meals will receive a 50% subsidy on shared, individual 15 and 20 minute lessons and a 33% subsidy on a

individual 30 minute lesson with free instrument hire. Lessons start from £6.10 for a 30 minute group lesson
