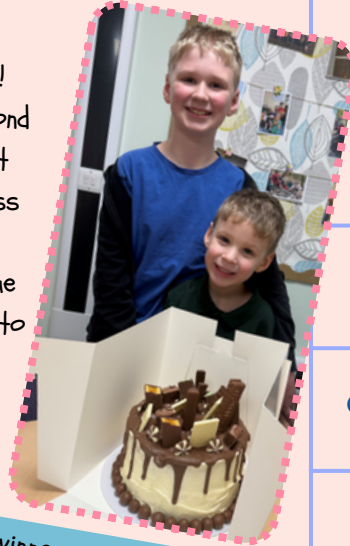
PE Timetable next term

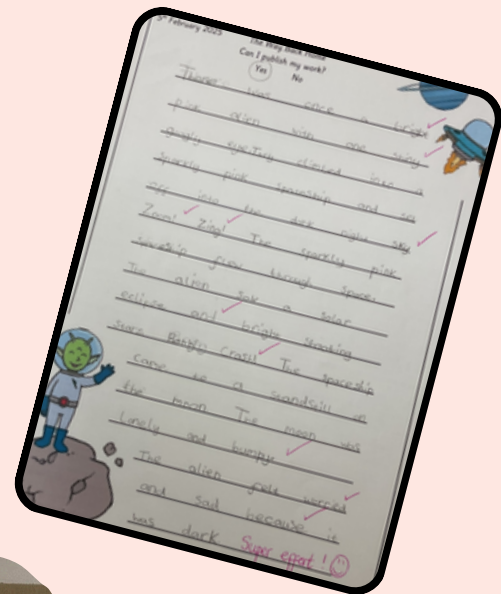
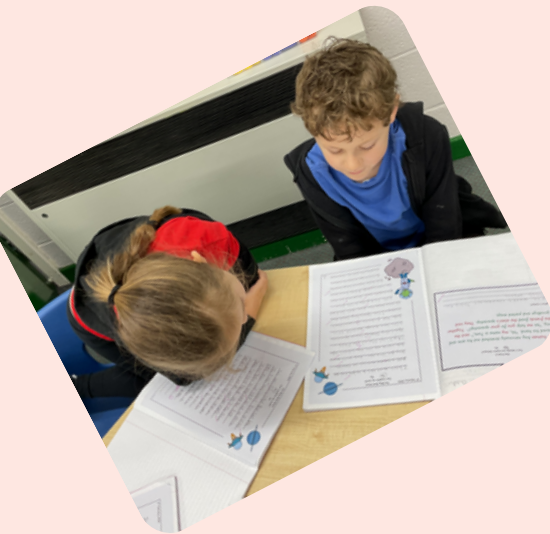




Maple Class

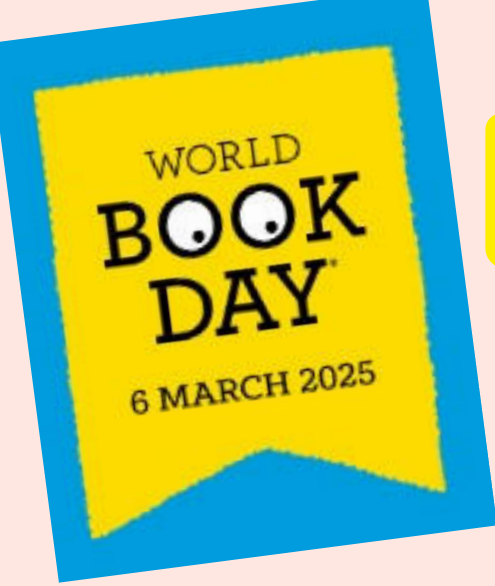


The children read stories aloud as part of National Story Telling week.
