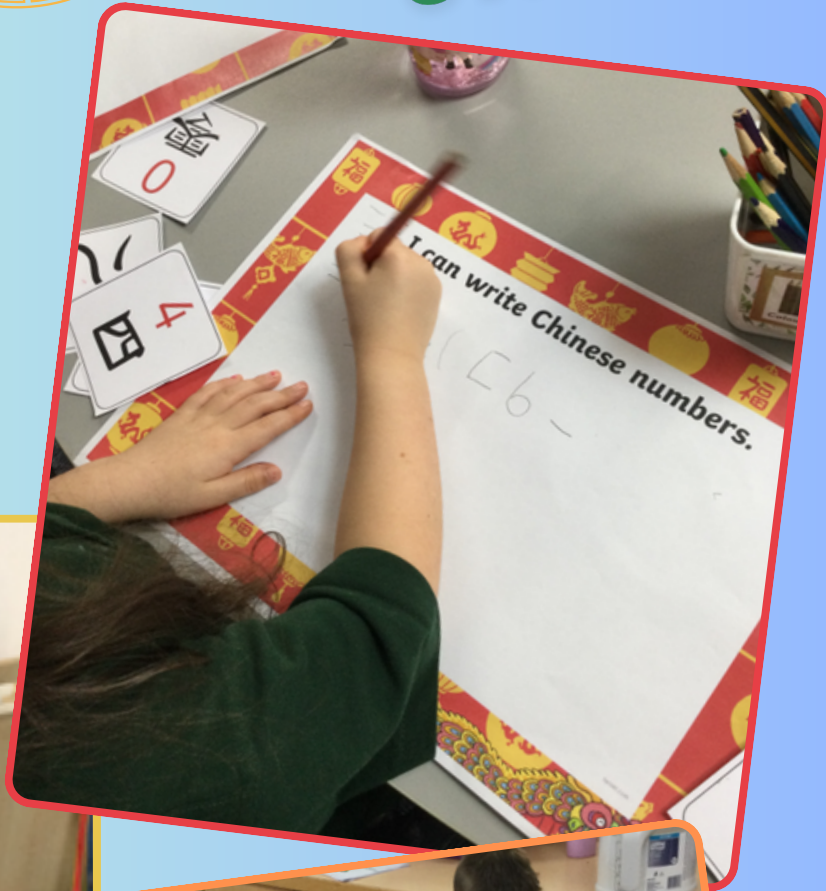

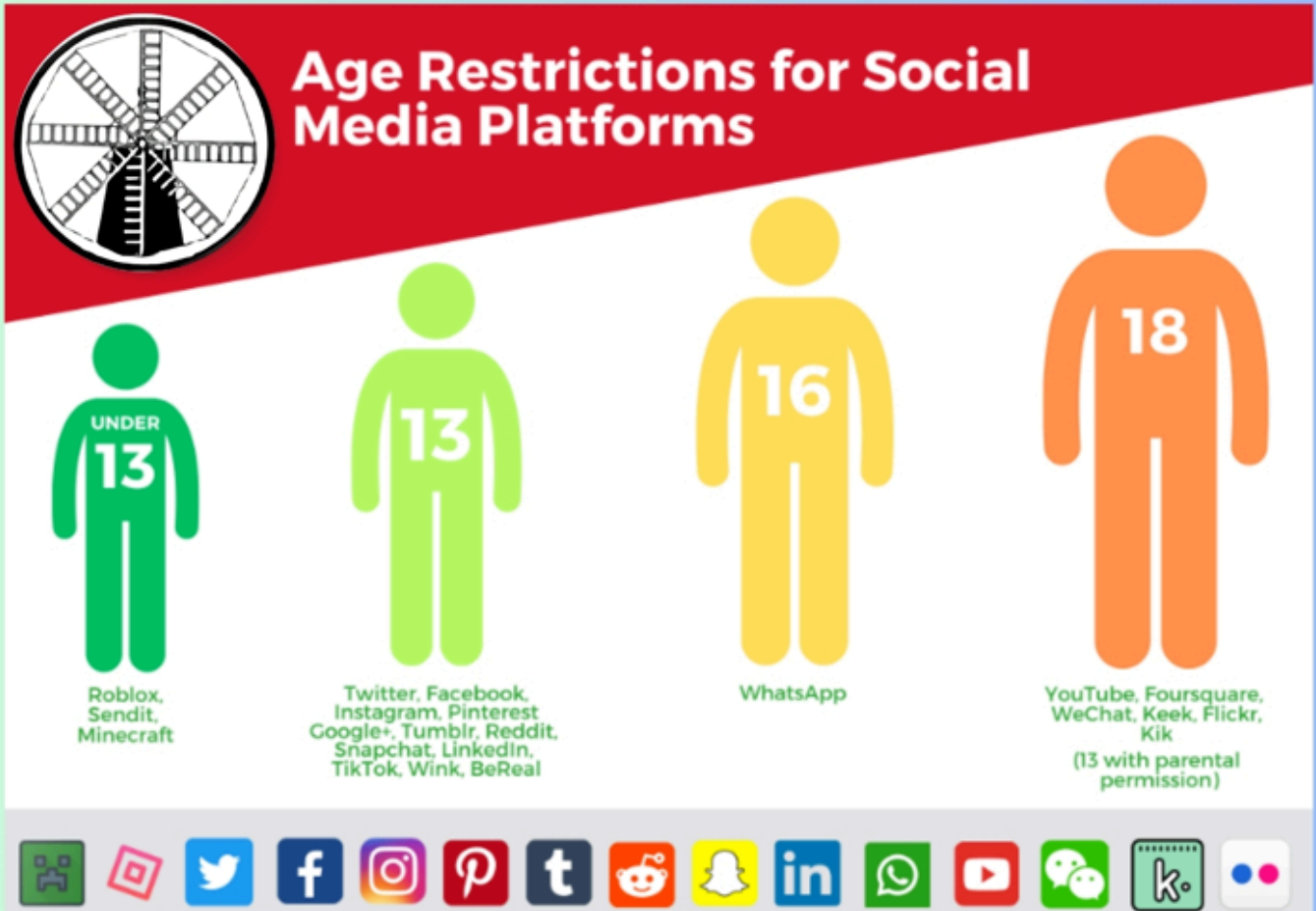
oak class have been celebrating chinese new year; the year of the snake! they have been writing chinese numbers; making and decorating paper lanterns & snakes.
